

Inclusive Histories Submission Guidelines

Objectives:

Our goal is to foster the ongoing and collaborative efforts of Davidson College students, faculty, and staff to deliberately consider the ways in which we construct and communicate stories about the past. In this site, we intentionally link the records kept in our archives, the lived geography of our campus, web-based technology, and the process of scholarly inquiry. We are particularly interested in identifying where specific groups have been omitted from existing historical narratives, researching their experiences, and reconceptualizing those narratives to be inclusive, relevant, and accessible.

Submissions:

Essays should be no more than 1,000 words in length and written in accessible language for a general audience.

Cite sources in endnotes using [*Chicago Manual of Style \(17th edition\)*](#) notes-bibliography format.

Include between three and five JPEGs of primary sources.

We prefer that at least one come from the archives of Davidson College. We need written permission to use material held in private collections and other archives on this webpage.

Scan files to approximately 1 MB as a standard.

Do not color correct or otherwise alter images before submission.

Professor Stremlau and the student project manager will provide guidance for revision and make final editorial decisions.
