

# STUDENT CONDUCT

1. **Gentlemanly Conduct.** Davidson students are expected to conduct themselves as gentlemen. Any student who is guilty of ungentlemanly conduct or whose conduct is such as to attract unfavorable attention to himself or to Davidson College may expect disciplinary action. This action may be expulsion, suspension or some lesser penalty depending on the seriousness of the offense.

2. **Honor Offenses.** Any student found guilty of cheating, stealing or lying in official statements is subject to dismissal immediately.

The Faculty feels free to deal firmly with any act which clearly involves basic dishonesty regardless of the specific form which it may take.

3. A student found guilty of gambling or immorality is ordinarily dismissed from the College.

4. **Financial Responsibility.** Since financial integrity is important in the conduct of Davidson College students, all students will be required to settle satisfactorily all outstanding financial obligations whether of personal liability, bad checks, personal debts or of some other nature which are brought to the attention of the Dean of Students. The decision as to timing and manner of satisfactory termination of outstanding obligations will be determined by the Dean of Students.

5. **Alcoholic Beverages.** Davidson College is opposed to the use of alcoholic beverages by students. A student will ordinarily be suspended if he is found guilty of violating any of the following regulations:

- a. No student shall consume or be under the influence of an alcoholic beverage (1) while he is within the Town Limits of Davidson or on the campus of Davidson College (which includes the Lake Campus) unless he is within the home of his immediate family or (2) while he is in attendance at any event which is sponsored by Davidson College or in which student representatives designated by the college are participating.
- b. No student shall have an alcoholic beverage in his possession within the Town Limits of Davidson or on the campus of Davidson College other than in the home of his immediate family or in the locked trunks of student automobiles.
- c. No student shall transport, have in his possession or consume an alcoholic beverage during the period bounded by his travel to and from an event in which he participates as a designated representative of Davidson College.
